Election Update on Housing Policies

- State of California – Prop 1 PASSED: \$4 billion in bonds for existing affordable housing programs for low-income residents, veterans and farm workers.
- State of California – Prop 2 PASSED: Tax revenue on \$2 Billion in bonds for housing people in need of mental health services.
- State of California – Prop 10 FAILED: Repeal Costa Hawkins Act - Expands local governments' authority to enact rent control on residential property.
- National City Rent Control – Prop W FAILED.
